Concerns: responsibility dangerous consequences facemask obligation

Dear Sir, Madam,

Herewith you receive a writing from the foundation "Ik wil gewoon naar School". The foundation is committed to the interest and the safety of students in primary and secondary education related to the government issued Corona measures. We are doing this by informing and if needed by litigating against the government and educational institutions as well as their director or principal.

Through this letter we draw your attention as an educational institution and school-director/ principal, to your legal duty of care (art. 4c WPO and art. 3b WVO) with regard to the physical and mental health of your students. Failure to meet the requirements of this duty of care means that you can be held responsible for any physical and mental damage to your students as a result of the Corona policy as carried out by you or your institution (art. 6:162 BW). This includes both short- and long-term damage.

As an educational institution you are responsible for the way in which you implement the government policy on the Corona measures. In this letter we focus on the wearing of face masks and on possible (future) Corona measures, such as a test obligation and/or (indirect) mandatory vaccination.

Unfortunately, we are receiving a lot of reports from concerned parents about the detrimental effects their children are experiencing due to the forced wearing of face masks. In addition, the effectiveness of facemasks in preventing infection has not been scientifically proven. With regards to this and because of the before mentioned duty of care, you as an educational institution should refuse face mask mandate for your students. Especially because this is in conflict with article 3 paragraph 1 of the International Treaty on the Rights of a Child (OHCHR): *"on all measures regarding children, no matter if these are taken by public or private institutions for societal wellbeing or by judicial institutions, administrative authorities or legislative bodies, the interest of the children should be the first consideration."*

Unfortunately, we must conclude that the interest of children in the Corona policy of the government and schools is the last consideration. It riles us that various educational institutions implement the face mask mandate even wider and harsher than the government. For example, by not recognising the exception rule, by requiring facemasks to be worn in classrooms and on the school grounds, by verbally intimidating



students and denying them access to the school. A few primary schools are requiring students from years 5 and 6 (in Dutch schools groups 7 and 8) to wear a facemask while this is only an advice.

The physical and mental damage students have built up due to the (long term) wearing of face masks concerns us greatly. This damage is apparent from scientific research. On our website (<https://ikwilgewoonnaarschool.nl/verdieping>) you will find a large collection of articles and publications with scientific evidence from specialists about the ineffectiveness and harmfulness, of which the following are the most common:

- The disbalance of oxygen causes headaches, dizziness, concentration problems and damage to cells and organs;
- The accumulation of bacteria and fungi causes infection diseases such as skin infection, bacterial lung infection and inflammation of the heart valves;
- Pieces of textile and toxins cause tissue damage in the lungs;
- Mental and psychosocial damage is caused by feeling oppressed and experiencing disruption of non-verbal communication and speech development.

It is possible that the above had been insufficiently known to you and calls for questions. If this is the case, we recommend that you research the damaging consequences you expose your students to.

We draw your attention to your duty of care and your duty of information collection. For this we refer once more to the articles on our website (<https://ikwilgewoonnaarschool.nl/verdieping>). In case you have doubts about the face mask mandate, and are also concerned about the wellbeing of your students, we are willing to check if we can use our legal and medical team to aid you. Various educational institutions have already shown interest in this.

If despite the dangerous consequences for your students you are of the opinion that you have no other choice than to implement the face mask mandate in your educational institution, then you should take into account that we may start a legal procedure against you. Through this writing your attention has been drawn to your legal duty of care for the wellbeing, health and safety of your students and you can also decide to put the interest of your students first. This is your legal and moral obligation and hiding behind government policies will not absolve you of this.
